

Locations for Photographs

Many people come to us photographers and ask...."where should we go for photos...."

This is a very hard and open ended question! There are a lot of options for location photos in the Macarthur area, depending on the look and style of photos you are after. Macarthur boasts many historic and rustic venues right through to ultra modern locations and everything in between. You must remember that much of the time what is in the background of the photo may well be out of focus or cropped to concentrate on you in the picture

This list of possible photo locations has been designed as a guide to some places to look at for your wedding location photos. It contains venues that may have a charge associated with the use of the property, to other locations which may be something quite different and even free. This list is by no means exhaustive; it is a starting point to make your own enquiries. From information we can gather, all parks in Campbelltown are free to use but require a booking to ensure photos do not clash with other public events that may be scheduled at the same time. Macarthur Park in Camden is the only park that requires a booking and has a fee required. All other parks in Camden LGA are free. Always when looking for a venue for your location photos, keep these tips in mind:

1. Locations should be large enough to accommodate you and your bridal party
2. Most photographers need at least an hour for photography
3. Make sure you have permission to be on the grounds
4. Make necessary bookings and/or pay necessary fees well in advance
5. Check out the options available for photography at your church or ceremony location and your reception. In many instances there is no need to travel to another location just for photos if you have a lovely church grounds and there is no other wedding booked in after your ceremony, you can make use of the church and it's surrounds. In many cases reception venues have beautiful gardens to use for photography AND you have paid to be there already. Check with the reception venue that there is no other function booked in at the same time and what time you can arrive for photos
6. In the event of wet weather, alternative locations (with sufficient space for group photography) are the responsibility of the Bride and Groom. If you're worried about the weather – have a location which does have access to shelter. A park with covered BBQ area is all that you need or a nearby café for somewhere different.
7. Understand that to get great photographs, you and your wedding party's co-operation with your photographer is absolutely vital.
8. Only employ a professional photographer. Don't put pressure on Uncle Fred to record this momentous occasion. He may take good holiday snaps but he probably doesn't understand lighting/posing, or know how to make you look your best.
9. Some of the best locations may be on the side of the road on the way from the church to the reception. Go for a drive one weekend and keep your eyes open!
10. Go to a location that actually means something to you, like the park where you got engaged or the pub where you first met or the historic house you used to visit as a small child. This will give your photos more meaning than just going to the local park because it was close to the reception.
11. Check out the sunset times sheet printed on page XX of this magazine; use it as a guide to set the times of your ceremony and photo shoot. Put in the hard work early then you'll be able to kick back and enjoy your special day!
12. Remember common sense. If using a Park or Private venue, keep noise and disturbance to a minimum, don't leave a mess and take your rubbish with you. What you and your bridal party do today will influence what other couples can and can't do tomorrow.
